



Student Registration

1. Log into your Blackboard student site with your **Username** and **Password**.
2. Select **Course** and then the course you are registering your ResponseCard for.





3. Select **Course Tools** from the left hand side menu.





4. Select **TurningPoint Registration Tool** from the menu.





5. Enter the 6 digit **Device ID** found on the back of the ResponseCard (or the 8 digit ResponseWare ID) and click Submit.




